

# Student Outcomes by Degree Level



St. Cloud Technical & Community College monitors student persistence and completion rates. The College offers undergraduate programs at the associate degree level along with certificates and diplomas. Outcomes for the most recent, complete five cohorts are presented here. ## One-year Persistence, Graduation, and Transfer Rates

The following data reflect the outcomes of all degree-seeking students entering SCTCC in the fall of each year. Each entering fall cohort is tracked for one year. Each student is assigned a single outcome with the following priority: graduated if they completed a program, retained if still enrolled, transferred & graduated if they left SCTCC but completed a program at their transfer institution, transferred if they left SCTCC but did not complete a program at their new institution within one year, and not retained if none of these apply. Note that most students are not expected to graduate within one year, but some do transfer in with completed credits or complete short programs.


