1. Attach \$20 (U.S) check or money order for the admission processing. *Processing will not begin until fee is paid.*
2. English translations of all educational transcripts must be sent directly to the Admissions Office by institutions previously attended or certified copies by school official enclosed with this application.
3. Provide scores for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL-500 minimum is required in written, 173 on computer version and 61, [with not less than 15 on reading, writing and listening sub scores] using the on-line version of the test).
4. Return the Confidential Financial Information Form, along with recent official bank statements (*must be English translated*).

Incomplete files will remain on file for **one year** only, pending the receipt of missing documentation. Failure by the applicant to provide required documentation within one year will result in the need to initiate a completely new application including the application fee and all documentation.
