

Gainful Employment Disclosure Report

The U.S. Education Department's gainful employment regulations require disclosure of certain program information to students and prospective students. Gainful employment programs are those "that prepare students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation." Public institutions are required to report this information for all undergraduate and graduate programs that are Title IV eligible that lead to certificates, diplomas, graduate certificates or specialist awards. Reporting is not required for undergraduate certificates and diplomas less than 16 credits, graduate certificates and specialist awards that are less than 8 credits. Degree programs at all levels are not considered to be gainful employment programs.

Gainful employment regulations require disclosure of the following information:

- Information on occupations that the program prepares students to enter
- Program costs including tuition and fees and book and supplies
- Median federal and private loan debt of recent graduates
- On-time completion rate of recent graduates
- Job placement rate of recent graduates.
