

Non-Disclosure of Directory Information

- Major
- Dates of attendance & enrollment status
- Degrees and awards received (including Dean’s List or President’s List honors)
- Height and weight of members of athletic teams
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- Photograph or photographic likeness
